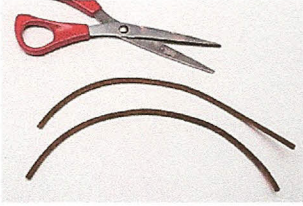
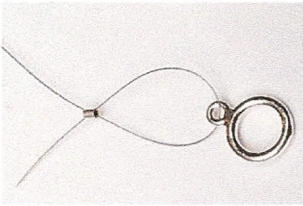


# How to use Velveteen Tubing

## No 1: Jewellery Wire



**1)** Determine the desired length of your necklace and add about 20cm (8in) to this measurement then trim the jewellery wire to that length. Determine the desired length of the Velveteen Tube and cut two equal pieces.



**2)** Thread one of the crimps and one side of the clasp on one end of the wire. Thread the wire back through the two crimps and pull the wires firmly up to the clasp leaving a short tail of about 4cm.



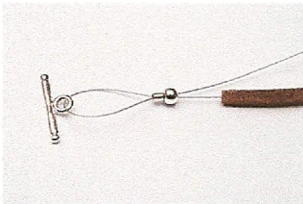
**3)** Using flat-nose pliers squash the crimp firmly to secure the clasp in place then tug on the crimp to ensure it is secure. If it slides squash it again.



**4)** Thread one small bead, one piece of velveteen tube then another small bead onto the wire.



**5)** Thread the assorted beads in your desired arrangement positioning the Focal Pendant in the central position. Finally thread one small bead, the other piece of velveteen tube and another small bead.



**6)** Thread the remaining crimp and the other half of the clasp. Go back through the crimp and the last small bead.



**7)** Pull the wire up ensuring there are no gaps in the wire then squash the crimp as before. Using the wire cutters trim the jewellery wire close to the exit bead.
