

## Bead Spider Stringing Inspirations

1. Two tone teardrop bracelet – use three strands of tigertail, thread all three through one bead then separate the wires and thread 4mm beads on the two outside wires and 6mm beads on the centre wire, Bring all three wires through one silver bead. Repeat for the remainder of the bracelet.
2. Two tone teardrop necklace – use two strands of tiger tail and start with one small bead at centre front then separate the four strands using two strands through the centre 6mm beads and one each side for the 4mm beads. Bring all three wires through one silver bead and repeat. Separate the strands and thread each side.
3. Fan Bracelet – use two strands of tiger tail, thread one side of the bracelet then separate the wires and thread 4mm beads on one side and 4 and 6mm beads on the other then crossover the wires through a 4mm bead. Bring strands together to complete the bracelet.
4. Weave bracelet – use two strands and thread two beads on one and one on the other then bring together and thread both through one silver bead.
5. Illusion Bracelet - use three strands and a ruler to space the beads and keep them in place using a crimp each side of the bead sets.



6. Illusion Drop Necklace – Make the necklace in two halves cut two double lengths of tigertail and attach the middle of one wire to each side of the clasp. Use a ruler to space the beads and keep them in place using a crimp each side of the bead sets. Bring the wires together at the centre front and thread and crimp a 6mm bead. Separate the wires and thread and crimp beads varying the lengths of each wire.
7. Two strand with Velveteen Tube – use two strands of tigertail through the tube then separate them to thread the beads. Bring the strands together to go through the tube on the other side.
8. Simple two strand bracelet
9. Focal Bracelet – use two strands through the sides; separate the strands to thread the centre section.
10. Illusion Necklace – use two strands and a ruler to space the beads and keep them in place using a crimp each side of the bead sets.
